With reference to your application dated 12/11/2024 & subsequent correspondence / inspection of the school this regard.

I, Education Officer (Primary) for a period of three years from 01/04/2025 to 31/03/2028 for a period of three years from Std. 1<sup>st</sup> to STD. 8<sup>th</sup> English Medium, Sheth Vasantben Natwarlal Charitable Trust Seth Vidyamandir English High School, Vasant Nagari, Vasai East, Taluka Vasai, Dist. Palghar, is provisionally approving this school.

The above approval is subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions.

- The period of recognition shall not be extended and there shall be no obligation under any circumstances to grant recognition or affiliation after Class VIII.
- The school shall comply with the provisions of the Children's Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Appendix One) and the Maharashtra Right to Children's Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Appendix Two).
- The school shall admit children from the nearest weaker sections and disadvantaged groups, in the first grade, to the extent of at least 25 % of the number of students in that grade and provide them with free and compulsory education up to the completion of primary education but further, this standard shall be complied with in the case of pre-primary grades also.
- In respect of children specified in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per section 12(2) of the Act, provided that a separate bank account shall be provided to the school for receipt of such reimbursement.
- The institution / school shall not charge any capitation fee and shall not compel the child or his or her parent or guardian for any screening procedure.
- No child shall be denied admission to the school for lack of proof of age, religion, caste or caste, place of birth or any of these.
- The school shall follow the syllabus prepared on the basis of the syllabus prescribed by the appropriate authority.
- The school shall comply with the students as per the facilities available in the school as prescribed in Section 19 of the Act.
- The school shall admit students against the facilities available in the school as prescribed in section 19 of the Act.
- The school shall adhere to the standards and norms specified in Section 19 of the Act. The facilities available in the school at the time of previous inspection were as follows -
  - Area of school premises - 6455.03 sq.m.
  - Total construction area = 2070 sq.m.
  - Area of playground = 2162 sq.m.
  - Number of classrooms - 57
  - Office-N-Store-N-Principal's Room - 04
  - Separate toilets for boys and girls - where there is sufficient water for use and to keep the toilets in a clean and hygienic condition -
    - For Boys - 36
    - For girls - 47
  - Drinking water facility - Tap
  - Kitchen for cooking lunch - Yes
  - Availability of teaching study material and sports and sports material and library - Yes
  - Reading material is freely available - Yes

OVT. OF INDIA

Unapproved classes or units cannot be run in the school premises or elsewhere in the name of the school.

The school building or other construction or playing field shall be used only for the purpose of education and skill development.

- The school is run by an organization registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) or the Bombay Public Welfare Act, 1950.
- The school is not run for the benefit of any individual, group or association of individuals or any other person or for making any profit.
- Accounts of the school should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts should be prepared as per rules. A copy of each account statement should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.
- Please note that the code received by your school is PALGHAR/VASAI/CBSE/UGR/2024, please mention it in any correspondence with this office.
- The school should submit such reports and information as may be demanded by the Director of Education / District Education Officer from time to time or follow the instructions given by the administration or the local authority for continuous fulfilment of the conditions of recognition of the school or to eliminate the errors in the functioning of the school.
- Ensure renewal of registration of organization if any.
- Addendum - Three other terms are attached to it.
- Re-recognition of your school is being given as per the proposal submitted by you and subject to the recommendation of the Block Education Officer, Panchayat Samiti Vasai. If the documents submitted in the proposal are found to be false, your re-accreditation will be cancelled and criminal charges will be filed against you for furnishing false information.
